of filing documents. "I like the ease of the system. When I make a phone call, I log it in the Correspondence binder under Records of Conversations. This is a listing of who you talked to, what time you talked to them, what action is required, when it is due, when it was given to you and what you received."

Because data is so well organized within the Paragon system, pulling together reports is simple. Johnson said that if a program manager isn't available and one of the program team members needs an update, it is very easy to drill down to the record level of any cost or corresponding program document.
